



Mask Liner FFD

AirFit F10, AirFit F20, AirTouch F20

Extra Padding Included, tuck into the pocket if needed



- Remove the headgear straps from the mask, leave the silicone cushion on.
- Place the arms of the mask through the slits (photo #2) with the Velcro on the hose connection side of the mask away from your face.
- Pull the pointed seam of the mask liner up over the top of the cushion.
- Pull the legs up and secure Velcro, blue magnet will show (Photos 3 and 4)
- Flip the mask over and smooth the liner over the cushion pulling all sides taut.
- Make sure the pad inside (to protect your nose bridge) is smooth. The mask should look like (Photo #6).
- Re-attach the headgear straps to your mask.

Make certain no exhalation vents are covered with the Mask Liner

Note: You may need to cut the hole larger to accommodate your nose or mouth, do this with sharp scissors <u>a little bit</u> <u>at a time</u>. It is very easy to get the hole too large.

These photos are with the AirFit F20 mask, but it fits both the F10 and the F20


